

Adjunct Faculty Position with Tufts DPT Seattle – Wound Care Content

- Tufts DPT Seattle is an accelerated, hybrid DPT program and we are looking for an adjunct faculty member to teach the wound care content!
- The content is integrated into a second-year course that will start in Spring 2026 (Jan – April)
- The wound care content will span 2-3 weeks that will be instructed remotely via asynchronous and synchronous lectures and 1-2 days of in person lab in Seattle.
- The adjunct faculty will be responsible for the following, in collaboration with the primary instructor:
 - Creation of asynchronous lectures utilizing universal design for learning that covers the appropriate content based on the 2023 Entry-Level PT Curriculum Recommendations for Integumentary/Wound Management.
 - Designing and leading the 2-hour synchronous lectures (once per week) for 2-3 weeks to apply the asynchronous content learned with a backward classroom design.
 - Create and lead the 1-day in-person application of wound care with emphasis on entry-level patient care.
- Financial compensation will be provided and may include travel expenses, depending on the departure location.
