Academy Committees and/or Areas of Need

- Federal Affairs** – focuses on public policy, legislation, and consumer education – we are especially in need of individuals interested in consumer and public education and health literacy.
- Membership** – collaborates with Academy committees/SIG on member recruitment and retention initiatives. At least one rep from each area of practice.
- Nominating** – (election only, not appointments) – develops yearly slate for Academy elections and manages elections process
- Practice** – advances practice through member education and other initiatives. At least one rep from each area of practice.
- Education** – approves and manages Academy programming at CSM and collaborates with Academy committees/SIG to develop continuing education opportunities. At least one rep from each area of practice.
- Research** – promotes research by members and selects abstracts for presentations at CSM
- Publications and Communications** – develops and maintains electronic newsletters, eblast notices, website, etc.

Special Interest Group

- Wound Management** - provides a forum for Academy members having a common interest in physical therapy for wound and integumentary management to meet, confer, and promote patient care through education, clinical practice, and research.
- Electrodiagnosis** - provides a forum where individuals interested in electrodiagnosis may meet, confer, and promote patient care through education, clinical practice and research, as well as multi-disciplinary dissemination of PT-based knowledge.
